# St. John's Nursery School COVID-19 Positive and Close Contact Protocol

# TEST OR PRESUMED POSITIVE FOR COVID-19 (ISOLATE)

### You are REQUIRED to:

 Stay home and isolate for 5 calendar days (the first day of symptoms is counted as day zero)

# If you had symptoms, you may return to school on Day 6:

- If you are fever free for 24 hours (without use of fever-reducing medication), AND
- If your symptoms are improving, AND
- REQUIRED to wear a mask for 5 additional calendar days

# If you had NO symptoms, you may return to school on Day 6:

- If you remain symptom free, AND
- REQUIRED to wear a mask for 5 additional calendar days

If you develop a fever or other symptoms, your isolation period would start over with symptom onset date as Day 0.

## If you are severely ill with COVID-19:

• You should isolate for at least 10 days before returning to school.

# EXPOSED TO SOMEONE WITH COVID-19/CLOSE CONTACT (QUARANTINE)

#### **HOUSEHOLD EXPOSURE**

#### You are REQUIRED to:

- Stay home for 5 calendar days, AND
- Wear a mask for 5 additional calendar days

It is recommended you test on Day 5.

If you develop symptoms, stay home and get tested.

# **SCHOOL/COMMUNITY EXPOSURE**

### **Parent Choice:**

• Stay home for 5 calendar days

#### -OR-

- May report to school
- REQUIRED to wear a mask for 5 calendar days

If you develop symptoms, stay home and get tested.

#### IF YOU DO NOT WISH YOUR CHILD TO BE MASKED, YOUR CHILD MUST REMAIN HOME FOR 5 ADDITIONAL CALENDAR DAYS
