COVID-19 Positive and Close Contact Protocol
(Reviewed 07/14/23)

**TEST OR PRESUMED POSITIVE FOR COVID-19
(ISOLATE)**

You are REQUIRED to:

- Stay home and isolate for 5 calendar days (the first day of symptoms is counted as day zero)

If you had symptoms, you may return to school on Day 6:

- If you are fever free for 24 hours (without use of fever-reducing medication), AND
- If your symptoms are improving, AND
- REQUIRED to wear a mask for 5 additional calendar days

If you had NO symptoms, you may return to school on Day 6:

- If you remain symptom free, AND
- REQUIRED to wear a mask for 5 additional calendar days

If you develop a fever or other symptoms, your isolation period would start over with symptom onset date as Day 0.

If you are severely ill with COVID-19:

- You should isolate for at least 10 days before returning to school.

**EXPOSED TO SOMEONE WITH
COVID-19/CLOSE CONTACT (QUARANTINE)**

HOUSEHOLD EXPOSURE

You are REQUIRED to:

- Stay home for 5 calendar days, AND
- Wear a mask for 5 additional calendar days

It is recommended you test on Day 5.

If you develop symptoms, stay home and get tested.

SCHOOL/COMMUNITY EXPOSURE

Parent Choice:

- Stay home for 5 calendar days

-OR-

- May report to school
- REQUIRED to wear a mask for 5 calendar days

If you develop symptoms, stay home and get tested.

IF YOU DO NOT WISH YOUR CHILD TO BE MASKED, YOUR CHILD MUST REMAIN HOME FOR 5 ADDITIONAL CALENDAR DAYS

In the event of multiple Covid-positive people within the same class (believed to be from in-class spread), that class will transition to virtual instruction.
